- : Bright accent with golden new growth
- : Retains gold color

- : Intermediate growth to 6' in 10 years
- : Upright pyramidal form

**Pinus nigra 'Green Tower'**

- : Very columnar Austrian
- : Medium grower to 6ft in 10 years
- : Very short limbs, will not break in snowload
- : New in production in USA; tried and true in Holland and Germany

- : Best production choice
- : Fat, full form
- : Vibrant blue green twisted needles
- : Grows to 6' in 10 years

**Acer plamatum dissectum 'Jeddelloh Orange'**

: Indroduce by Jeddelloh Farms  
 : Orange veins and margins on green dissected leaves.  
 : Vigorous grower good for production  
 : Three season colors with good orange read fall hues

**Acer plamatum 'Skeeter's Broom'**

: Dwarf witch's broom to Bloodgood'  
 : Compressed stems make a dense, full medium sized tree  
 : Brilliant red new growth goes purple/red in summer and bright red fall color.  
 : Upright habit good for small gardens

**Acer shirasawanum 'Autumn Moon'**

: Colorful larger leaved Full Moon maple with intense pink and rose spring leaves.  
 : Golden summer color can take the sun better than others.  
 : Fall color is orange/red. Excellent small tree for smaller landscapes.
